Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I would ask for the following division; Ms. Kay Lynn Goldner be voted on separately, and the other two as a unit.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is divisible. For discussion on the appointment of Kay Lynn Goldner to the State Foster Care Review Board. Senator Jensen, you're recognized to close. Senator Jensen waives closing. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report of the Health Committee of Kay Lynn Goldner to the State Foster Care Review Board. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of that component of the Health Committee confirmation report.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is agreed to. For discussion on the second part of the divided question, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: For the final time this session, Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, for the reasons I've given in the past for voting in the negative on these male appointments, I am so voting on these two. The negative vote has nothing to do with the suitability or qualifications for the position to which they are appointed.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Jensen, you're recognized to close. The question before you is the adoption of the confirmation report from the Health Committee, second part of the divided question. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The confirmation report is agreed to. Members, while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose to sign and do sign, LR 263, LR 265, LR 267, LR 264, LR 228, LR 235, LR 268, LR 269, LR 270 and LR 271.
