I would remind you that we don't pass any of these until a budget, revised budget, comes to us on the floor, so there is plenty of time to worry about that. I would also...I don't want to leave any misimpressions from what Senator Tyson said. There is no revised fiscal note on this because we just passed the amendment this morning. You can't have a revised fiscal note until you have something in writing. So I would suggest that we do go ahead and send this along with the bill and on Select File I'm sure there will be an amendment that you will be asked to put on the fiscal note on the A bill. So, with that, I would appreciate your support of the advancement and I suppose we better call the house on this one too, Mr. President.
