SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I really thought all that. I wanted to make it clarified because I wasn't sure. I hear that complaint occasional that people are outside the zoning or the jurisdiction of the city, but in the zoning jurisdiction with no representation.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: So they mandated here, they do have one, may have two in all others that we are not talking about here, but I want to clarify that.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Hartnett, your light is next.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I simply want to rise to support this amendment. As I say, we do allow the cities below Lincoln and Omaha to have two members from this area, but they must have one, because I think the people that live in this three-mile area, and we've heard it for years, feel like they are in no man's land, that they don't have any representation. And so by giving one person on the planning department, we allow them to have some voice or a person from that area. So I would ask for support of the amendment and for the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hartnett, there are no more lights. Would you like to close? Senator Hartnett does waive closing. The question before the body is, shall the committee amendments to LB 367 be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.
