SENATOR BRASHEAR: Well, in parents who have become separated because of disagreement, I suspect two can have opposing points of view, both views...and each wants to train up the child in the opposing view.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Amendments to be printed: Senator Schimek to LB 654; Senator Quandahl, LB 126; Senator Schimek, LB 654A; Senator Landis, LB 931; Senator Schimek, LB 480A; Senator Chambers to LB 120. And LB 897, heard by the Business and Labor Committee, is reported indefinitely postponed.

Mr. President, a series of adds: Senator Bruning, to LB 1319; Senator Crosby, LB 1405; Senator Dwite Pedersen, LB 1267 and LB 1410, LB 1417; Senator Connealy, LB 1425. (Journal reflects Senator Vrtiska asked unanimous consent to have his name added as a cointroducer to LB 1405.) Senator Quandahl would like to remove his name from LB 1269; Senator Hilgert, (add name) to LB 1194. (Legislative Journal pages 423-425.)
