SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the suspension of rules? Senator Bromm. He waives off. I see no further lights. Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I'd just like to thank everyone who's come to me this morning and expressed their condolences. I appreciate that very much, and I'll see everybody here, back here, on Thursday.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is, shall the rules be suspended to permit the cancellation of a previously scheduled hearing notice? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Please record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The rules are suspended.

CLERK: Mr. President, pursuant to that action, I have a hearing notice providing for cancellation of the hearing on LR 304, signed by Senator Schrock as Chair of the committee.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Other items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, Revenue Committee confirmation report, signed by Senator Wickersham. Senator Brown, an amendment to LB 1135; Senator Landis, LB 1135; Senator Landis, LB 957; Senator Thompson, LB 652A. Appropriations Committee reports LB 1425 as indefinitely postponed. And a new resolution, Mr. President, LR 311, offered by Senator Stuhr. (Read by title for the first time.) That will be laid over at this time, Mr. President. That's all that I have.
