SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused (sic--unauthorized) personnel please the floor. All unexcused senators please check in. The house is under call. Senator Bourne, Senator Bromm, Senator Kristensen, Senator Coordsen, would you please check in. The house is under call. Mr. Clerk, all present or accounted for. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 922-923.) 28 ayes, 12 nays on the advancement, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 414 does advance to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk, next item. I do raise the call and, Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Amendments to be printed by Senator Coordsen to LB 968, Senator Hilgert to LB 925, Senator Dierks to LB 957, Senator Chambers to LB 973. New resolutions. (Read LR 312-313 by title for the first time.) I have a hearing notice from the General Affairs Committee, a confirmation report from Business and Labor, and Health and Human Services Committee reports LB 1427 to to General File with amendments attached.
