SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. President, members of the body, this is the A bill that was promised to you when we adopted the amendment to LB 1107 on General File. This is an A bill that would appropriate an additional \$13 million for the TEEOSA program in the next distribution of state aid; not the one that will be coming up in the current...in the next fiscal year, but the one after that. It is the result of calculating the objective on the basis of all schools rather than just equalization schools, but it is...it is evidence of the fiscal impact that we discussed on General File. I'd simply ask your support for the A bill so that it can catch up with the bill, itself, that is now on Select File. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Debate on the advancement of LB 1107A. Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close. Senator Wickersham waives closing. The question is the adoption, excuse me, the advancement of LB 1107A to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1107A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 1107A is advanced. Mr. Clerk, Final Reading.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Stuhr would move to return LR 20CA to Select File for specific amendment, AM2570. (Legislative Journal page 863.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Stuhr, you're recognized on your motion to return to Select File LB...LR 20CA.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, and members of the Legislature. What I seek to do with this amendment is to strike "general election in November" and insert "primary election in May" and I would hope that you would support this consideration in bringing the back...bill back in order to do this. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. For debate on the motion to return to Select File LR 20CA, Senator Kristensen.
