SENATOR CROSBY: Time.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...period of time, I hope you give it to them. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. You've heard the closing. The question is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 171. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on LB 171. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 17 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill does advance. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I thank you...thank you, Madam President, I do. A series of amendments by Senator Beutler to LB 628; Senator Schrock, an amendment to LB 1234, all to be printed. Enrollment and Review reports LB 557, LB 652, LB 652A, LB 717, LB 717A, LB 922, LB 922A, LB 950, LB 950A, LB 994, LB 1125, LB 1190, LR 291CA, all those reported as correctly engrossed. Madam President, there will be an Executive Session of the Agriculture Committee underneath the north balcony now; Agriculture Committee, north balcony, now. That's all that I have. SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next, Mr. Clerk, the next bill.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 1348, a bill by Senator Wehrbein. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 19 of this year, referred to the Agriculture Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Madam President. (AM2527, Legislative Journal page 889.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. (Visitor introduced.) Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on LB 1348.
