SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Chambers. I think we're technically...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, okay.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...under Final Reading and so we're under call. I'm going to ask all members to check in to make sure everyone is here. Members, please check in. All members being present, you've heard the closing. The question before the body is, shall we reconsider the override veto vote which was taken? All those in favor of reconsideration vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? A request for a roll call vote has been made by Senator Chambers. Mr. Clerk, please read the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 972-973.) 28 ayes, 19 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The motion to reconsider fails. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 20CA. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, new A bill. (Read LB 1214A by title for the first time.) Appropriations Committee reports LB 1214 to General File with amendments; LB 1215 to General File; LB 1216, General File with amendments; LB 1217 to General File with amendments; LB 1349, General File with amendments; LB 1369 to General File. A series of amendments: Senator Beutler, an amendment to LB 171 to be printed; and Senator Hilgert to LB 953. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 973-976.)
