SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY:    Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Reverend Chris Lenning and he's from Hooper, Nebraska. He's from Senator Janssen's district. Chaplain.

REVEREND LENNING:    (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CROSBY:    Thank you very much. I now open the forty-first day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, Second Session. Roll call. Will the senators please record your presence. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk, you may record, please.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY:    Thank you. Any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY:    Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: I have a report of registered lobbyists for this week to be inserted in the Legislative Journal; Senator Beutler, amendments to LB 628; and a new resolution, LR 317 by Senator Kremer. (Read by title for the first time.) Madam President, it will be laid over at this time. Thank you. It's all that I have. (Legislative Journal pages 1001-1005.)

SENATOR CROSBY:    Thank you. Senators, would you please take your seats for Final Reading. Would you please take your seats for Final Reading. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. We are under Final Reading. Would the senators please take your seats for Final Reading, and all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Mr. Clerk, first bill.

CLERK: (Read LB 74 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY:    All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.
