possible that if we go down this path, at 45 percent, that we may very well be looking at increasing the level of income taxes and sales taxes. And I don't think that we have a population that can bear those increases. So I'm going to support the amendment; I hope that others will do so as well, because I do believe that it improves the bill. Then you can make a decision whether you think that this is a general philosophy that you would share as a policy for our state in funding our schools. Thank you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Redfield. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk?
