PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I urge you to pull the bill and let us continue to do our work. Thank you. (Microphone malfunction) for call of the house.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is, shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 43 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Would members please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Roll call vote, please, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1163-1164.) 28 ayes, 17 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting on the motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Motion is agreed to, LB 1405 is placed on General File. Mr. Clerk, ... (Applause) No. (Gavel) Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a Reference Report referring certain gubernatorial appointments to Standing Committee for confirmation hearing. Your Committee on Education reports LB 1010 to General File with amendments. Senator Kristensen has an amendment to LB 968 to be printed. And Enrollment and Review reports LB 352, LB 1092A, LB 1348A and LB 1427A to Select File. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1164-1167.)
