CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1410, Mr. President, LB 1410A by Senator Wehrbein.
(Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. Speaker, members, very briefly, this is \$15,000 annually, starting in '01-02. The commission is to sunset in 2007, so it will be over a three- or four-year period. It also creates a fund to work this money through and it will also be expected to have...a cash fund I should say, that money is expected to be...receive money from grants and gifts and so forth. And so that's the bill, A bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Debate on the advancement of LB 1410A? Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: There's a mural right in this Chamber if you want to...where did you say it was? Right up there. So it's celebrated in this body. That's...I should close with that. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: You're welcome. The question is the advancement of LB 1410A. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1410A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1251, a bill by Senator Raikes. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13, referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments. (AM2371, Legislative Journal page 641.)
