CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, we have one motion with respect

confirmation hearing. Senator Bohlke would move to suspend
rule...rules with respect to cancelling a public hearing
scheduled for today.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Bohlke,
you're recognized on your motion to suspend the rules.

SENATOR BOHLKE: (Laugh) Thank you, Mr. President and members.
Yes, the Education Committee asked to suspend the rules for the
confirmation hearing. The nomination has been withdrawn. We
were going to hold the hearing after adjournment. And so, as
you know, it takes 30 votes and so I would ask for your support
in suspending the rules. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Debate on the suspension of the rules?
Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to close. Motion is to
suspend the rules to cancel a hearing. Those in favor vote aye,
those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President on the motion to suspend
the rules.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is adopted. Mr. Clerk, items
