CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, on the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted. Debate on the advancement of LB 972A. Senator Brown, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President and members, even though the General Fund amount is about \$4 million...a little over \$4 million over the two year period, the federal amount is seven and a half million dollars. And I just want to say once again that I appreciate that the federal government is helping us to collect child support. I appreciate that we've been able to work out with the federal government the fact that we are not including another \$3 million in this fiscal note, and urge its adoption. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brown. The question is the advancement of LB 972A to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 972A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Senator Wehrbein, amendments to LB 1410A and LB 1381A to be printed. That's all that I have. (Legislative Journal pages 1609-1610.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill is a bill by Senator Wickersham. (Read title of LB 1330.) Bill was introduced on January 19 of this year, referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President.
