SENATOR WEHRBEIN: But it's because it's throughout a long area of the bill...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...law, right?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: There are no other lights on. Senator Wickersham, did you wish to say anything in closing on your amendment? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Wickersham amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the Wickersham amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The Wickersham amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Smith, a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1067 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The motion is to advance LB 1067 to E & R for engrossing. Those in favor please say aye, opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1167, Senator. I have Enrollment and Review amendments. (AM7264, Legislative Journal page 1487.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 1167.
