changes the statutes so that we can accept a gift from the federal government. It's...it's nearly a technical amendment but not quite because it does allow for us to accept the gift in...from the federal government. As I said, it's a Corps of Engineer building and 1.84 acres of land that will fit very nicely in with Arbor Lodge State Park in that they will have a closely...in close proximity this maintenance building that they can use for Arbor Lodge State Park. Game and Parks is using...paying for this from cash funds. The maintenance on that will be done by the Game and Parks. There is some work done on this. It has been run now through L...309 Committee and I think everything is in order for acceptance of this gift, and this statute change will allow that.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Debate on the Wehrbein amendment? Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close. Senator Wehrbein waives closing. Question is the adoption of AM3273 to LB 1410. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1410 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 1410. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. LB 1410A.
