have much other choice, and I'm sure there are some very good things in LB 1279. But I think we made a big mistake by adopting that portion of the Wickersham amendment that presented basically, in my opinion, a significant policy change from what we enacted last year in LB 179. I'm going to withdraw this bracket motion because I don't think I'll have the support to carry it through, but I am going to introduce an amendment on Select to try and change just that portion...excuse me, on Final to try and change just that portion of the bill that I believe is going to have a significant impact on disabled people who are poor. Mr. President, please withdraw that bracket motion. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is withdrawn. Debate on the advancement of LB 1279. Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close on LB...Senator Wickersham waives closing. Senator Wickersham, would you like to make a motion.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1279 to E & R Engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 1279 to E & R. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
