CLERK: 40 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is adopted. Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: (Read LB 819 by title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Have you voted? Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1750.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. LB 819A.

CLERK: (Read LB 819A on Final Reading.)
