8 Eagle Award on Saturday, March 24, 2001; and

9 WHEREAS, Todd has served in the Boy Scouts since 1991 as  
10 a Tiger Cub and Cub Scout; and as a member of the Webelos Eagle  
11 Patrol, he earned his Arrow of Light Award in 1996; and

12 WHEREAS, as a member of Troop 96, Todd, for his Eagle  
13 Scout service project, installed playground equipment at the Camp  
14 Clarke Raiders area, leading a group of Scouts and Camp Clarke  
15 Raiders in designing, preparing the site, installing the equipment,  
16 and landscaping the area; and

17 WHEREAS, Todd, a sophomore at Bridgeport High School, in  
18 becoming an Eagle Scout, has achieved a rank that fewer than four  
19 percent of all boys who join the Boy Scouts attain; and

20 WHEREAS, Todd Hoerler, throughout his Scouting career,  
21 has represented his troop and community with excellence.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE  
23 NINETY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:
