search warrant, and I think that's appropriate. And so I do believe, even from the standpoint of Senator Chambers, that this amendment improves the bill. So...and I again want to thank Senator Brown and Senator Brashear and others, Senator Janssen, who have contributed to what we're talking about here and the issue. And I would encourage you to adopt the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of AMO692. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted. Items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Natural Resources reports LB 634 to General File. General Affairs reports LB 11, LB 828 as indefinitely postponed. Health and Human Services reports LB 468, LB 668, to General File; LB 580 to General File with amendments; and LB 788 as indefinitely postponed. Enrollment and Review reports LB 433, LB 433A, LB 505, to Select File, some having Enrollment and Review amendments. And Enrollment and Review also reports LB 303, LB 303A, LB 314, LB 360, LB 419, LB 484, LB 730 as correctly engrossed. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 920-922.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. It's close to eleven o'clock, and it's close enough that we're going to move over on the special order, General File, LB 170. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 170 is a bill on General File; a bill originally introduced by the Revenue Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 4, referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AMO245, Legislative Journal page 544.)
