Health, to whom was referred LB 372, reports the same back with a recommendation it be indefinitely postponed, likewise with LB 562, LB 570, LB 615, LB 623, LB 693, LB 694. Business and Labor reports LB 180 to General File with amendments; LB 185, General File with amendments.

Mr. President, new A bills. (Read LB 170A and LB 436A by title for the first time.) I have a hearing notice from the Health and Human Services Committee. A reminder, Mr. President, that the Revenue Committee will hold an Executive Session at 1:15 today. Senator Wickersham has selected LB 772 as his priority bill for the session; Senator Maxwell, LB 678. And Senator Suttle would like to print an amendment to LB 23, and Senator Bromm to LB 574. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 957-960.)
