March 15, 2001 LB 286, 368

CLERK: LB 286, Mr. President, no E & R. Senator Chambers would move to amend. (AM0727, Legislative Journal page 833.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I presume this is the Chambers amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir, it is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I will move that it be adopted, and I have discussed this with Senator Janssen, so he is aware of it, and that's all the amendment does. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Debate on the Chambers amendment? Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close. Senator Chambers waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM0727 to LB 286. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I move the advancement of LB 286 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 286 to E & R for engrossment. Those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 368. I do have E & R amendments first of all, Senator. (AM7057, Legislative Journal page 828.)
