PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to LB 114. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. I move the advancement of LB 114 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 114. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. The bill is advanced.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Members, we will pass over LB 563 and move early to the General File, 2001 committee priority bill that was scheduled for three o'clock we will take up at this point in time. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 142 was introduced by Senator Schimek and others. (Read title.) Bill was read for the first time on January 4, referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. That committee reports the bill to General File with committee amendments attached. (AM0226, Legislative Journal page 529.)
