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FLOOR DEBATE

March 28, 2001 LB 750, 768

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...that sort of...okay. Well, I...thank you, Senator Pederson. I would just mention that the...this bill did come...was heard in the Education Committee. It...there were no opponents testifying. And the vote out of the committee was 8 to 0. So I would urge your support. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Pederson, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. Once again, I really appreciate the efforts not only of those I mentioned, but you as legislators, because you were the ones that voted to put this into law in Nebraska. And I think it's one of the things that we can do for our own citizens. And I appreciate your efforts, and I ask you to advance this bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Pederson. The question is the advancement of LB 750. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 750.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 750 is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 768, a bill by Senator Schrock. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17 of this year, referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee for public hearing, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM0792, Legislative Journal page 933.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Schrock, you're recognized to open on LB 768.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature, LB 768 is an enabling statute for LR 14CA, which
