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milk marketing area. If we're in line with the price, why I guess I'd like to keep it there. If we're not, why then I don't care if you change it. Oh, and the other think I wanted to talk about, you mentioned something about Dan Glickman a little bit ago, a report that he said. He was a House member from Kansas and he was defeated in election during the big Republican revolt, what, six years ago, whenever. It was the middle of the Clinton...or maybe somewhere in the middle of the Clinton administration. And so then he was given the...he took Secretary Espy's place who was the Secretary of Agriculture, and he was given that position. I've had some correspondence with Dan Glickman, and I can't say that I've been all that pleased with it. His background in agriculture was that his parents owned a scrap yard in Kansas, and so I think that I have as much right to dictate or state what policy should be as he does. The last correspondence I had with him was one way. I wrote to him asking him to enforce the Packers and Stockyards Act. He never answered it, and I've written now to Ag Secretary Veneman, sending a copy of the letter that I sent to him, and I send these to all of our congressional delegations so they know that I'm at least wanting to find out if we're going to have enforcement of the Packers and Stockyards Act. So far I haven't heard from Secretary Veneman either. But I think my letter is fairly reasonable, and I just had to comment on your remarks about Dan Glickman because I'm not sure that he has the best interests of agriculture at heart. Thank you.
