PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. The question is the advancement of LB 772. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Voting on the advancement of LB 772. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 772.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Brown has an amendment to LB 827 to be printed; Senator Wickersham to LB 657. A series of adds: Senator Jones to add his name to LB 277; Senator Bruning, LB 277; Senator Baker, LB 277; Senator Kristensen, LB 823 and LB 824. (Legislative Journal pages 1255-1256.)

Mr. President, a priority motion. Senator Jones would move to adjourn until Thursday morning, March 29, at nine o'clock a.m.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall the Legislature adjourn? Those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. The Legislature is adjourned.
