CLERK:      Mr. President, thank you. Bills read on Final Reading this morning have been presented to the Governor. (Re LB 52, LB 55, LB 101, LB 114, LB 170, LB 170A, LB 240, LB 759.) New A bill, LB 740A, by Senator Landis. (Read by title for the first time.) Senator Chambers has amendments to LB 808, LB 750, and to LB 827 to be printed. New resolution, Mr. President, to LR 53, by Senator Erdman. That will be laid over. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1288-1290.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 461. I have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all, Senator. (AN7073, Legislative Journal page 1146.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 461.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 461. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK:      Senator Chambers would move to amend AM1087. (Legislative Journal page 1228.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

CLERK: It's one of your effective date amendments, Senator, I think.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I was going to say it's good you recognized me because I don't recognize the bill. But this is what we call the Chambers amendment now, as a shorthand. There's a reference to either a federal statute regulation or something in Nebraska statute, and this will simply make it clear that we are referring to that as it exists on the
