SENATOR SMITH: I move that LB 516 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to advance LB 516 on for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 543 to Select File with Enrollment and Review amendments attached; LB 542; LB 666; LB 666A; and LB 849. Mr. President, Education Committee reports LB 573 to General File with committee amendments attached, and LB 799, indefinitely postponed. Mr. President, amendments to be printed, Senator Wehrbein, to LB 543; and Senator Coordsen to LB 313A. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1697-1703.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. As the agenda reads, Select File, 2001 Speaker priority bills. Mr. Clerk, LB 420.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no Enrollment and Review amendments. Senator Kristensen would move to amend. (AM1664, Legislative Journal page 1661.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kristensen, to open on your amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, this particular amendment deals with the area of bonds which is the underlying bill's purpose and intent. And it seems prudent for the Legislature to deal with all of these issues in one bill this year. And I appreciate Senator Bromm's patience in doing this. This amendment is LB 127, which was the State Auditor's bill, this was the second year that she has had this bill that I've carried for them. We ran out of time last year and so not to run out of time this year, basically what this does is remove obsolete language from the registration of coupon bonds, excuse me. Historically, those coupon bonds were kept with the Auditor; she has a whole basement full of these things. No one has looked at them for many a good long year.
