LB 154A, 773

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. Senator Chambers, I move the advancement of LB 154A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion is, advance LB 154A to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 773, Senator Chambers would move to return LB 773 to Select File for a specific amendment. (AM1651, Legislative Journal page 1685.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment to return.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, this is the one known as the Chambers' amendment. And on page 10, line 2, after 75-363, we would insert "as such regulation existed on the effective date of this act". And then the language appears two additional times. That is the amendment that I will ask you to adopt. But we must return the bill first, in order to do that.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion on the motion to return. Seeing none. Senator Chambers, do you waive...do you wish to close on your motion? Waives closing. The question before the body is, return to Select File for specific amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on a motion to return for a specific amendment. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to return was successful. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment, AM1651.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Having explained the amendment, I ask that it now be adopted.
