CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1931.) 31 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 305A is advanced. Call is raised. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. A series of study resolutions, LR 139-143, all will be referred to the board. I have a hearing notice from Transportation Committee. Senator Bruning amendment to LB 593; Senator Coordsen to LB 536; Senator Burling to LB 852. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1931-1935.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll move to Final Reading, members. LB 538E. Members, if we can please return to your desks we will begin Final Reading. Pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is shall LB 538E be considered for a vote without an at-large reading? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is agreed to. Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: (Read LB 538 by title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Members, we are on Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1935.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed with the emergency
