SENATOR DIERKS: Well, I think that's right, yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is it on any fuel that they pay taxes, or only ethanol-blended fuel?

SENATOR DIERKS: Well, I don't know, but I know they do on ethanol-blended fuel.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you be willing, if we ever got to that point, to say that these credits could be applied against the taxes only on fuel that is ethanol blended?

SENATOR DIERKS: I don't think I could do that, Senator Chambers. I'd have to...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well...

SENATOR DIERKS: ...I'd have to know what other products they get the credits for. I don't know that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If it's motor vehicle fuel, what other products would there be other than that which contains ethanol and that which does not?

SENATOR DIERKS: I don't know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I don't see Senator Wehrbein, so let me ask Senator Kremer a question. Senator Kremer, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kremer, are you available?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Kremer,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kremer, for a question, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...would you yield to a question? Senator Kremer,...

SENATOR KREMER: Yes. Okay.
