SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock.

(Laughter) Because Senator Schrock, it's a moot point because we know Congressman Osborne wouldn't be able to bring home the bacon if any of these projects are in a part of the state that's going to be representative...that have...that are now represented by Doug Bereuter.
