with me, and I'm going to find every way I can to see that our employees are fairly treated. You all wouldn't even get your expense bills if it wasn't for me. I overrode a Governor's veto and got it into court by having to threaten the Attorney General to take it myself because he said we should not be paid our expenses. I said then you challenge the bill in court. That's where it belongs because we overrode the Governor's veto and that's the law. So then he took it to court in order not to be embarrassed. And I worked with the lawyer who...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...handled the case. And you get your expenses, not because of people like Senator Bruning or Senator Wickersham or others who say this cannot be done. There were Attorneys General Opinions that said we could not get expenses and some senators hid behind that. But when they got the expenses, they didn't turn that money back and say it violates my principles. They're willing to let somebody do the work. Well, this is work I intend to do. Mr. President, I withdraw this emotion...this motion.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: With the motion, so done. Mr. Clerk, LB 772.

CLERK: (Read LB 772 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 772 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2193.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 772 passes. LB 772A.
