SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 329, on Select File. I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all, Senator Erdman. (AM703, Legislative Journal page 825.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 329.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment by Senator Schrock. Senator, I have AM1089. I have a note you'd like to offer as a substitute AM1961.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no objections, so ordered.

CLERK: AM1961, Senator Schrock. (Legislative Journal page 1914.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're recognized to open then, Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, AM1961 is the work of the Natural Resources Committee and a lot of other people involved, some of them behind the glass. AM1961 is really LB 634, that was introduced by Senator Beutler, with numerous modifications. And I believe we put out about ten different plans, and finally the tenth plan was something that everybody could agree to hate the least. (Laughter) So, this is the one that everybody can get along with and kind of go home
