difficult as the burden of proving that they intended to kill the child that the person was carrying. Senator Foley's version removes that burden to some extent, and if you can simply show that the perpetrator intended to kill the mother and if that...and that resulted in the death of the child, then you have a conviction potentially, under Senator Foley's bill. Now that is very much a, I think, a policy question and I want to be sure we all think about, understand, it's not without precedent, Senator Foley's suggestion. And that is what Senator Bourne was alluding to in terms of, I think, 28-303 or crimes where if I decide that I'm going to blow up a building, and in the process of blowing up that building I kill 15 people, maybe I didn't even know the people were there, maybe I thought the people wouldn't be there. I for sure didn't have any premeditated intent to kill those people, I intended to blow up the building, but in the process of doing that, I killed these people. And so I can be prosecuted, and I can be prosecuted for felony murder, and so I think that...I think there's some similarity. I think that it's analogous. Now I think...I commend Senator Brashear and I commend Senator Foley on their efforts, both of them, now with respect to these proposals before us. I think they're pretty good proposals. And from a prosecutor's standpoint, I'm still leaning towards the Foley version right now, but I'm listening and I'm willing to listen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: And I want to be sure that whatever we come out with here, that it is a good law because it does absolutely no good, in the criminal area especially, to pass a bad legislation. And to the extent that Senator Chambers has tried to teach us that or tell us that, I wholeheartedly agree because there's a lot of wasted effort, expectations, time and resources that go into enforcing, or trying to enforce bad laws and eventually they're stricken down. So whatever time it takes to sort this out and decide which is the better law, we need to take that time, and it may not all be able to be done on General File either. But those are some thoughts that I have. I need to take some more time and study this language. I think I can...
