SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: (Recorder malfunction)...Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator George Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen, for doing that for us. I call the twelfth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they have examined and reviewed LB 848 and recommend that same be placed on Select File, LB 848A.
