going to be able to get five different tests, which is very important and I think it's going to speed up the process and give a much better result back to the individual. But all we're laying out in there and then in that second sentence, the department may use administration fee to pay for the cost of central data and all of the following items, the registry, tracking system, and everything else, still it's only \$10, and so I think we're putting a lid on what those costs may be.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so if I'm...if I'm understanding you correctly, we could delete the word "costs" there in line 5 of the Standing Committee amendment because you already have covered the laboratory testing fee and the administrative fee. Would that be accurate?

SENATOR JENSEN: I don't think we're adding extra costs. I would just like to maybe run that by the department first.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, I mean it's no reason it couldn't wait till Select File, even if it needs to be done,...

SENATOR JENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...but I just wanted to...

SENATOR JENSEN: And I would be glad to do that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...get your input on that. Okay.

SENATOR JENSEN: I think we're talking about the same thing here.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Byars, did you wish to comment?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, I do, thank you. Yes, I do, Senator Beutler. What this does is it does some transferring of costs. It's going to replace, Senator Beutler, General Fund dollars and some federal funding...
