February 5, 2002 LB 474, 500

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 474 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. The question before the body is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It advances. LB 500.

CLERK: LB 500, Senator, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all. (AM7138, Legislative Journal page 314.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized to adopt those amendments.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 500.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. They're adopted.

CLERK: Senator Erdman would move to amend with AM2249. (Legislative Journal page 378.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members, LB 500, from General File, was a bill that relates to the controlled substances and the schedule...the Uniform Controlled Substance Act and the schedule that those different substances fall under.
