SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Items for the record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Amendments to be printed: Senator Bruning to LB 752, Senator Jensen to LB 391. The Committee on Agriculture has designated LB 588 as priority bill. Committee on Revenue reports LB 878 advanced to General File; LB 1064 advanced to General File; LB 884 indefinitely postponed; LB 1030, LB 1113 also indefinitely postponed. Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 326 to Select File; LB 326A, and LB 22, LB 22A, and LB 235A to Select File, some with E & R amendments. Name additions: Senator Bourne to LB 1272, Senator Kruse to LB 488, Senators Stuhr and Aguilar to LB 661, Senator Brown to LB 883, and Senator Wickersham to LB 20.
