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you, Senator Wehrbein, because again you're not laying out the state's strategy. But I do think that the public has a right to know more about these proceedings than the public knows right now. The public is the one whose pocket is going to be emptied after the bumbling and stumbling through the court system, and I can see the people in Washington mocking Nebraska because of the lack of sophistication. I talked to some of those guys who are defending the state. I was not impressed by them at all, not at all. This case is like the goose that is laying the golden egg. I feel like discussing more but I'm not because I promise not to at this stage, but on Final Reading I may have a motion after having talked to Senator Wehrbein. We, as a Legislature, have a responsibility to get our hands on information and not be so easily and quickly turned aside. I do not trust those who are handling the litigation for the state. They are interested in the money. The current Attorney General is going to be gone. He doesn't have to worry about it as a campaign issue. The current Governor can blame it on those who came before him. We are the ones who are going to pick up all the mess that has gotten here regardless of who may be responsible, regardless of how it got here. All the garbage person does is to pick up the refuse and dispose of it. You all are going to join me. I am the garbageman. You all are going to join me at some point in being garbage persons. And maybe then attention will be paid; maybe not. But there is a responsibility that I feel, as a member of this Legislature, to do more in the way of planning for the worst that can happen because I expect the worst to happen. I would like to ask Senator Wehrbein a question, since he's standing anyway.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Wehrbein, from what you have received in briefings and the summary that you have, are you confident that Nebraska is going to win the trial?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We have been assured that we will win the trial, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Who...who assured you?
