SENATOR RAIKES:      No, I think that answers my question. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    You're welcome. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    You've heard the closing on the Government, Military Affair Committee amendments to LB 722. Question is, shall those amendments be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of the committee amendments to LB 722. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    The committee amendments are adopted. Back on the bill itself, LB 722. Open for discussion. Senator Schimek, there are no lights on.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:    Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I would simply say that the committee amendments become the bill and I would ask you for the advancement.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    You've heard the closing on LB 722. The question is, shall LB 722 be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor of that advancement vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 722 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who wish to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 722.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    LB 722 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK:      Mr. President, LB 1086 is a bill by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) Introduced on January 14 of this year, referred to the Government Committee. Bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM2847,
