SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jones, you had mentioned something about the uniforms and said that since having this discussion you've seen them wearing both types of uniforms at a weigh station. Is that true?

SENATOR JONES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, would the guy have half a brown uniform on one side and half a blue one on the other, or he would wear a blue jacket and brown pants or brown...or just how would he wear both of them?

SENATOR JONES: There's three people out there in a weigh station, two had blue uniforms and one had a green.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, some different people were wearing different...

SENATOR JONES: That's right. That's right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...were wearing the uniforms? I thought you meant each guy was wearing both uniforms at the same time. Thank you for that clarification, Senator Jones. I can now relax again.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no further lights on, Senator Bromm. Do you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. I haven't heard any real opposition to the amendment. I would simply encourage the body to support FA1037.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. The question before the body is FA1037 to AM3384 to LB 470. All in favor of that vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Bromm amendment to the Kristensen amendment. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.
