April 10, 2002 LB 898, 898A, 947, 1085

49 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of LB 947.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 947 passes. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill, LB 898. The first motion I have is to dispense with the at-large reading of LB 898.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The question is to dispense with Final Reading. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 44 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Read the title, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 898.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1580.) 46 ayes, 3 nays on the final passage of LB 898, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 898 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, LB 898AE.

CLERK: (Read LB 898AE on Final Reading.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read Legislative Journal page 1581.) 46 ayes, 3 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 898AE passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, LB 1085E.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator
