**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** One minute.

**SENATOR BROWN:** And there are going to be pet pigs that are going to be slaughtered in this plan. And it's because we are in the serious situation that we're in, that we have to deal with some of these. But it's not going to be enough to just make these cuts and say, well, everything's going to be fine. We, as Senator Landis so eloquently said on the revenue side, on the spending side, also, we have structural problems. We have structural problems when you have aspects of our government that are increasing at such a rate that the core services that Senator Wehrbein spoke about, are jeopardized. And, so, we are going to need to take very seriously, and expect...
