Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President and members, Senator Wickersham, I don't...what's the A bill on this? And that's the only question I'd like to ask you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are you available Senator Wickersham?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Wehrbein, I think that if the amendment was adopted, we would see an amendment to the existing A bill asking for an additional \$180,000. We're talking to the analyst about that. We're not quite sure how that would be calculated. There is some difficulty here, and let me...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I would like to have my time...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Oh, I'm sorry.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...please. I have other...thank you, but I...I didn't mean to be rude, but I'm at my wit's end. After, not a pleasant weekend, I'm going to try once again to get across to this body the serious of our situation. And I'm particularly frustrated, those of you that are in your offices, I'd ask you to listen. I passed out, today, an update, and it's an updated action of what was here Thursday. And I want to call to your attention, we did 52 percent in cuts, \$214.8 million in cuts out of a \$400 million problem. And we did \$117 million in tax increases. But what I want to call your attention to is the 56.4 that I have in a box. That's called adjustments. But what I want you to understand is, that is one time. And when we come back again, and I'm not clear at this point whether it's going to be this year, but we know we'll be back next year, that money has to be made up by cuts because that is never going to be income again. So, I'm not...I may be responding a little bit to Senator Wickersham's \$180,000. I think what he needs to do...be done is needed, but I'm not going to spend \$180,000. Because those of you that want to cut and cut and cut our way out of this, and that's...I'm responding to the weekend rhetoric, believe me, and I'm responding to a postcard that came out about the "Nebraska Tea Party." It has these suggestions for cuts. I'm going to tell you what those cuts are. They want to cut
