April 19, 2002 LB 1105, 1290, 1303

3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 1105 passes. LB 1290E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1290 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1290, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Senator Coordsen, for what point do you rise?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Roll call vote, please, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Been a request for a roll call vote. There's been a request for the members to check in prior to a roll call vote. Just a moment, we'll clear the board. Members, please check in. Senator Robak, Senator Quandahl, Senator McDonald, would you please check in? Thank you. Senator Coordsen has requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1794.) Vote is 19 ayes, 23 nays on the passage of the bill with the emergency clause attached, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 1290, with the emergency clause attached, does not pass. The next vote is the passage of LB 1290 without the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record. There's a request for a record vote, Mr. Clerk. Excuse me. Senator, it is a record vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1794-1795.) Vote is 16 ayes, 22 nays, 8 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 1290 fails. We'll skip over LB 1290A. LB 1303.
