SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1303 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1795.) Vote is 42 ayes, 1 nay, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 1303 passes. Now, members, we...I want to give you a little guidance on where I think we're going to go. Senator Wehrbein, I'm going to recognize you in just a moment. We're going to...the legislative resolutions, I would ask that each of the introducers give a short introduction. The reason we have to do this is that the rule that automatically adopts these congratulatory ones can't work for resolutions introduced at the end of the session. So each one of the introducers, I'm going to ask you to give a very short description of what the resolution does. Then we'll vote on them together in one vote to do that. Then we'll try to move quickly through the confirmation reports. At this point in time we don't have any motions to override vetoes and we would proceed. These bills we're going to try to get over as quick as we can to the Governor to see if there are any of the matters that we passed today will be vetoed or not. There's a good working relationship that if there are they'll come back quickly, and so we want to wait and see and if there are any overrides we'll take them at that point in time, and then we'll move into the preparations for the end of session. Senator Wehrbein, I'm going to recognize you at this point in time for a point of personal privilege of the Chair to talk about your handout. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. Many of you have asked for a summary of the fiscal activities that we've done during this session and I thought I'd spend a few minutes, with your indulgence, to go over what is in this and, first of all, I want to recognize and thank the Fiscal Office, who happens to be up here at this point, to watch for final...our final session, but they're responsible for all the hard work
