LB 388 would have amended section 77-2702.07 to terminate the extension of the sales tax to include more services that was enacted last year in LB 1085 on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2003. The services to be eliminated from taxation on that date included building cleaning and maintenance, pest control and security, motor vehicle washing, waxing, towing, and painting, computer software training, and installing taxable personal property.
