A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to cities of the second class and villages; to
2 amend section 17-966, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska; to change membership provisions for facility
4 boards; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
5 original section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 17-966, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 17-966. In each ~~such~~ city or village where a facility as
4 provided in sections 17-961 to 17-966 is established, the mayor and
5 city council of such city, or the chairperson and board of trustees
6 of such village, as the case may be, may provide by ordinance for
7 the creation of a facility board which shall be composed of not
8 less than three nor more than ~~five~~ seven members. The members of
9 the board ~~who~~ shall (1) be residents of such city or village, (2)
10 have charge of the facility, and (3) have the power to establish
11 rules for the management, operation, and use of the same, as
12 provided by such ordinance. When a facility board has been
13 appointed and qualified, all accounts against the facility fund
14 shall be audited by the facility board, warrants against such fund
15 shall be drawn by the chairperson of such board, and warrants so
16 drawn shall be paid by the city or village treasurer out of such
17 fund.
